- Black and Orange Day: October 31st will be a seasonal colours day at SVPS, costumes, if your family
 participates, are best left for the evening's events. We strive to be an inclusive, inviting, culturally

 your child in/with a costume;
 - Please ensure that any costume your child might wear at school adheres to these principles.
 - Students must be able to engage in all aspects of the curriculum and school day (recess, DPA, Gym), safely.
 - Faces must be clearly visible, no costume masks,
 - o Props that represent a weapon of any kind are to be kept at home.
 - Costumes are worn at the "wearer's" risk as we cannot be responsible for mishaps, breakages or lost pieces.
- Check and dress for the weather: Be sure to check, or get your children (if they are old enough) in the habit of checking the weather each morning and dressing appropriately. Layers are best and a change of footwear that fits for indoor use can help to keep your child dry and comfortable during the school day.
- Names in clothes: Please take a few minutes to write your child's name on the tag of each of the hoodies, hats, coats, etc. that they wear to school. It makes returning them when they are left outside, so much easier and will cut down on the growing lost and found pile.
