School schedule:

9:05 bell: Yard supervision and student entry to the schoolyard begins

9:20 bell: The school entry bell

11:00 - 11:40 1st Break

Nutrition and Recess Breaks All students, grades K to 8, will eat for the first 20 minutes and then be outside for recess for the second 20 minutes for both breaks.

1:20 - 2:00 2nd Break

3:40 dismissal bell

Morning drop-off:

There will only be one entry point to the schoolyard, the South gate. Buses and other vehicles are to line up and wait to unload when staff are on duty. We ask that parents who are driving their children join the cue and wait until you reach the pyloned walk zone to let your children out. Please assist your child(ren) if they need assistance to get out of car seats, etc., More about bussing, below.

Where will my child go when they first arrive?

Your child will walk to the back of the school where they can play in the south yard. Support staff will be outside to meet and greet them.

New to Spring Valley, this fall?

If your children are new to the school, please follow the morning drop-off routine, explained above. There will be staff members just inside the South gate who will make sure they get to their teacher.

School or schoolyard access:

School doors are locked during the day so, please use the door buzzer to gain access and start your visit at the office. The *schoolyard is closed* to the public during the school day.

Running late?

You will need to park your vehicle at the front entrance and either send your child, or accompany a Kindergartener, to the front door, “buzz” the office. We will let them in and record their attendance.

End of the day:

Each class will walk to the bus loading area, out through the south gate, accompanied by their classroom teacher. Parents who are picking up their children in their vehicles, will park in a line behind the buses until the buses have departed. Children will walk to their parent’s vehicle. Parents can meet their children at the south yard gate.

Rainy day routine:

The drop-off and/or pick-up point will be the front doors, following the same routine as if at the South gate.

Early pick-up routine:

If you know that you will be signing your child out early, we ask that you provide notice to your child’s teacher and office. When you arrive at the school to collect your child, call the school number (613-475-2578) and we will call your child to the office. Children will not be called down to the office prior to your arrival. To avoid being trapped behind the buses, we recommend that you arrive to pick up your child by 3:20 pm

Bussing:
