#### What you need to know:

- Black and Orange Day: October 31st will be a "seasonal colours" Spirit Day at SVPS. As we strive to be an inclusive, inviting, culturally relevant and responsive school community built on mutual understanding and respect. We recommend that costumes, if your family participates, be left for the evening's events. However, if you plan to send your child(ren) to school in/with a costume, please review these "Costume Considerations" first. Additionally, consider the following,
  - o Students must be able to safely engage in all aspects of the school day (recess, DPA, Gym).
  - Faces must be fully visible, no costume masks.
  - o Props that represent a weapon of any kind are to be kept at home.
  - o Costumes are worn at the "wearer's" risk and are responsible for mishaps, breakages or lost pieces.
- Check and dress for the weather: Be sure to check, or get your children (if they are old enough) in the habit of checking the weather each morning and dressing appropriately. Layers are best and a change of footwear that fits for indoor use can help to keep your child dry and comfortable during the school day.
- **Names in clothes**: Please take a few minutes to write your child's name on the tag of each of the hoodies, hats, coats, etc. that they wear to school. It makes returning them when they are left outside so much easier and will cut down on the growing lost and found pile.
